

# SENATE . . . . No. 602

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To accompany the petition of Thomas R. Bateman, Counsel to the Senate, that provision be made for the typing of cards constituting an index of certain special laws of the Commonwealth. Rules of the two branches, acting concurrently.

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## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Eight.

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RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR THE TYPING OF CARDS CONSTITUTING AN INDEX OF CERTAIN SPECIAL LAWS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of expediting and  
2 promoting accuracy in the work of the general court,  
3 and of the several state departments, the counsel to  
4 the senate and the counsel to the house of representa-  
5 tives are hereby authorized and directed to cause  
6 to be typed upon cards the manuscript card index  
7 now existing of the special laws passed by the general  
8 court beginning with the year seventeen hundred and  
9 eighty and ending with the year eighteen hundred  
10 and ninety-nine, and for such purpose there may be  
11 expended by said counsel in the next fiscal year  
12 fifteen hundred dollars. Said index when typed on  
13 cards shall be placed in the office of the state secretary  
14 and shall be open to public inspection at all reasonable  
15 hours.
