AN ACT ABOLISHING SPECIAL LICENSES FOR OPERATORS OF MOTOR-PROPELLED FIRE APPARATUS, AND PROVIDING THAT NO FEE SHALL BE COLLECTED FOR THE RENEWAL OF LICENSES TO OPERATE SUCH FIRE APPARATUS ONLY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 90 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chap-
3 ter 399 of the acts of the current year, is hereby
4 further amended by striking out, in lines 19 to 22,
5 inclusive, as appearing in chapter 284 of the acts of
6 1937, the words: — “Special licenses shall be issued to
7 operators of motor-propelled fire apparatus who are
8 members of a municipal fire department.”

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 399 of the acts of the current
2 year is hereby amended by striking out section 2 and
3 inserting in place thereof the following section: —

4 *Section 2.* Section thirty-three of said chapter
5 ninety, as amended, is hereby further amended by
6 striking out the paragraph contained in lines eighty-
7 five to eighty-seven, inclusive, as appearing in the
8 Tercentenary Edition, and inserting in place thereof
9 the following: —

10 For every license to operate motor vehicles or any
11 renewal thereof, four dollars, but no fee shall be
12 collected for the renewal of a license restricted to the
13 operation of motor-propelled fire apparatus only.
