AN ACT PLACING UNDER CIVIL SERVICE CERTAIN EMPLOYEES  
OF THE REFORMATORY FOR WOMEN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 31 of the General  
2 Laws, as amended, is hereby further amended by  
3 adding at the end the following new paragraph: —

4 All permanent employees of the reformatory for  
5 women, except the superintendent, assistant and  
6 deputy superintendents, qualified physicians and  
7 registered nurses.

1 SECTION 2. The incumbents, on the effective date  
2 of this act, of the positions at the reformatory for  
3 women placed under civil service by section one of  
4 this act may continue to serve in their respective  
5 positions without taking a civil service examination,  
6 and their tenure of office shall be unlimited, subject,  
7 however, to the civil service law.
