AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPROPRIATION OF MONEY BY  
THE TOWN OF EDGARTOWN FOR ADVERTISING THE  
TOWN AND FOR PUBLIC ENTERTAINMENTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Edgartown may, by a  
2 two thirds vote, at an annual or special town meeting,  
3 after due legal notice, thereof in the warrants under  
4 which said meetings are called, appropriate annually  
5 a sum not exceeding three thousand dollars for the  
6 purpose of advertising the advantages of the town and  
7 for providing amusement or entertainments of a  
8 public character.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
