### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF MUNICIPAL LABORERS, FOREMEN, AND INSPECTORS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The provisions of sections eighty-one A, eighty-one  
2 B, eighty-three A and eighty-five E of chapter thirty-  
3 two of the General Laws, relating to the non-contribu-  
4 tory retirement of police officers and firemen in cities  
5 and towns, shall hereafter apply to all laborers, fore-  
6 men and inspectors employed by cities and towns in  
7 which said sections are operative.
