AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME FOR ACCEPTANCE OF AN ACT TO ESTABLISH IN THE TOWN OF NATICK REPRESENTATIVE TOWN GOVERNMENT BY LIMITED TOWN MEETINGS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 13 of chapter 2 of the acts of
2 1938, as amended by chapter 286 of the acts of 1943,
3 is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 6
4 and in line 7, the word "ten" and inserting in place
5 thereof, in each instance, the word: — fifteen, — so as
6 to read as follows: — *Section 13.* If this act is rejected
7 by the registered voters of the town of Natick when
8 first submitted to said voters under section twelve, it
9 may again be submitted for acceptance in like manner
10 from time to time to such voters at any annual or
11 special town meeting within fifteen years thereafter,
12 but not more than fifteen times in the aggregate, and,
13 if accepted by a majority of the voters voting thereon

14 at such an election, shall thereupon take effect for all
15 purposes incidental to the next annual town election
16 in said town, and shall take full effect beginning with
17 said election.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
