RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE MATTER OF COMPULSORY MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY INSURANCE PREMIUM CHARGES.

1 *Resolved*, That a special unpaid commission, to  
2 consist of two members of the senate to be designated  
3 by the president thereof, five members of the house of  
4 representatives to be designated by the speaker  
5 thereof, and three persons to be appointed by the  
6 governor, is hereby established for the purpose of  
7 investigating the method now used for fixing reason-  
8 able, adequate and nondiscriminatory premium  
9 charges for the purpose of compulsory motor vehicle  
10 liability insurance risks to the end that a more favor-  
11 able method might be substituted to accomplish the  
12 purpose for which the present compulsory motor  
13 vehicle liability insurance law was enacted. Said  
14 commission shall be provided with quarters in the  
15 state house or elsewhere, and may expend for legal,  
16 clerical and other expenses and services, and for travel

17 in and out of the commonwealth, such sums as may  
 18 hereafter be appropriated therefor. Said commission  
 19 shall report to the general court the results of its  
 20 investigation, and its recommendations, if any, to-  
 21 gether with drafts of legislation necessary to carry  
 22 said recommendations into effect, by filing the same  
 23 with the clerk of the house of representatives on or  
 24 before the first Wednesday of December in the current  
 25 year.
