AN ACT TO ENABLE THE COMMONWEALTH TO SECURE CERTAIN BENEFITS PROVIDED IN THE FEDERAL AGRICULTURAL MARKETING ACT OF 1946.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The state treasurer is authorized and directed to
2 receive all federal grants allotted to the common-
3 wealth under the provisions of Title II of Public
4 Law 733 of 79th Congress entitled "Agricultural
5 Marketing Act of 1946". All sums received by the
6 state treasurer shall be transmitted by him to the
7 trustees of the University of Massachusetts and shall
8 be expended by said trustees at said university in
9 carrying out the purposes of the said act.
