AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN INSURANCE COMPANIES TO
ISSUE POLICIES OF WINDSTORM INSURANCE WITHOUT
THE FIFTY DOLLAR DEDUCTIBLE CLAUSE, SO CALLED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

- 1 Every insurance company which offers insurance
- 2 protection against loss by reason of windstorm shall,
- 3 on request, issue policies of insurance against such loss
- 4 without the fifty dollar deductible clause, so called.
