AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR SEPARATE TAX BILLS FOR THE SUPPORT OF PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of  
2 chapters fifty-nine, sixty and sixty A of the General  
3 Laws, and any other provisions of law, the assessors  
4 of the city of Cambridge, when committing the annual  
5 tax list with their warrant to the collector of taxes of  
6 said city, shall make a separate tax list and warrant  
7 for the amount to be raised by taxation for the sup-  
8 port of the public schools as required by chapter  
9 seventy-one of the General Laws and notify the col-  
10 lector of the proportion which the annual school ap-  
11 propriation as voted by the school committee bears  
12 to the total sum to be raised by taxation in said year  
13 and also the amount of the annual tax rate required  
14 therefor. The assessors shall similarly notify the col-  
15 lector of the amount to be raised by taxation in said  
16 year.

1 SECTION 2. Said collector shall forthwith in ac-  
2 cordance with said chapters sixty and sixty A, after  
3 receipt of such tax list, warrant and said notice, send  
4 to each person assessed, resident or non-resident, the  
5 amount of his tax for the support of said schools.  
6 Such tax bill shall be captioned "Annual School Bill."  
7 The collector shall similarly send to each person as-  
8 sessed under chapter fifty-nine, General Laws, the  
9 amount of his tax bill to meet the amount required  
10 for the balance of the total amount to be raised by  
11 taxation in said year.
