AN ACT PROVIDING ADDITIONAL ACCOMMODATIONS AND FACILITIES FOR THE COURTS AND COUNTY DEPARTMENTS OF WORCESTER COUNTY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 98 of the acts of 1932 is hereby
2 amended by striking out, in line 5, the word "five"
3 and inserting in the place thereof the words:—
4 one million three hundred thousand dollars,— so
5 as to read as follows:— For the purposes aforesaid,
6 the treasurer of said county, with the approval of the
7 county commissioners, may borrow from time to time
8 on the credit of the county such sums as may be
9 necessary, not exceeding, in the aggregate, one million
10 three hundred thousand dollars, and may issue bonds
11 or notes of the county therefor, which shall bear on
12 their face the words, Worcester County Court House
13 Loan, Act of 1932. Each authorized issue shall con-

14 stitute a separate loan, and such loans shall be payable
15 in not more than ten years from their dates. Such
16 bonds or notes shall be signed by the treasurer of the
17 county and countersigned by a majority of the county
18 commissioners. The county may sell the said securi-
19 ties at public or private sale upon such terms and
20 conditions as the county commissioners may deem
21 proper, but not for less than their par value. In-
22 debtedness incurred under this act shall, except as
23 herein provided, be subject to chapter thirty-five of
24 the General Laws.
