AN ACT INCREASING BENEFITS UNDER THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW FOR PERSONS PARTIALLY UNEMPLOYED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (b) of section 29 of chapter 151A of
2 the General Laws, as amended, is hereby stricken out
3 and the following new subsection substituted there-
4 for:—

5 (b) An individual in partial unemployment and
6 otherwise eligible shall be paid the weekly benefit
7 rate to which he would have been entitled if totally
8 unemployed, but the weekly benefit rate plus his
9 wages for partial employment shall not exceed two
10 thirds of his average wage in the two highest quarters
11 of his base period.
