AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION OF MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT BOARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subdivision (4) of section 20 of chapter 32 of the
2 General Laws, inserted by section 1 of chapter 658
3 of the acts of 1945, is hereby amended by striking
4 out paragraph (c) and inserting in place thereof the
5 following:—

6 (c) The members of the board of any such city or
7 town may receive such compensation for their services,
8 as may be approved by the appropriating authority
9 as an item of expense, certified as required by sub-
10 paragraph (iii) of paragraph (c) of subdivision (7) of
11 section twenty-two. Members of the board shall be
12 reimbursed from the expense fund of such system
13 for any expense or loss of salary or wages which they
14 may incur through service on such board.
