By Mr. Connors of Waltham, petition of Louis B. Connors relative to the preparation, printing and political distribution of the so-called true lists of persons twenty years of age or older in cities and towns. Election Laws.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Nine.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PREPARATION, PRINTING AND POLITICAL DISTRIBUTION OF THE SO-CALLED TRUE LISTS OF ALL PERSONS TWENTY YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, IN ALL CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 6 of chapter 51 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the next to the last sentence
3 of said section and inserting in place thereof the fol-
4 lowing new sentence: — On or before May fifteenth
5 in each year, the registrars in all cities and towns shall
6 cause a sufficient number of such lists to be printed,
7 typed or mimeographed so as to furnish, free of charge,
8 such lists, upon request, to all duly organized political
9 committees and to all political candidates of the vari-
10 ous districts in which the city or town is located.
