AN ACT RELATIVE TO CONDITIONAL SALES OF MACHINERY AND EQUIPMENT TO WHOLESALERS AND JOBBERS FOR THE PURPOSES OF RESALE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 13H of chapter 255 of the General Laws,
2 as amended by chapter 468 of the acts of 1941, is
3 hereby further amended by adding after the word
4 "manufacturing," in line 4, the words:— or ma-
5 chinery or equipment sold to wholesale jobbers or
6 dealers for the purpose of resale, or machinery or
7 equipment sold to wholesalers or dealers for the pur-
8 pose of resale, — so as to read as follows:— *Sec-*
9 *tion 13H.* Sections twelve, thirteen, thirteen A,
10 thirteen D, thirteen E, thirteen F and thirteen G shall
11 not apply to conditional sales of textile machinery or
12 of other machinery used in manufacturing, or ma-
13 chinery or equipment sold to wholesale jobbers or
14 dealers for the purpose of resale, or machinery or

15 equipment sold to wholesalers or dealers for the pur-
16 pose of resale, or of seats for theatres, halls, parks,
17 and places of public assembly, or of parts, accessories,
18 appliances or equipment for any of the foregoing, or
19 to any contracts, leases, receipts or other instruments
20 evidencing or affecting such conditional sales or to the
21 rights, duties or obligations of the parties to such
22 contracts, leases, receipts or other instruments.
