AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES OF THE COMMISSIONER OF BANKS AND THE COMMISSIONER OF INSURANCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 26 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 591 of the
3 acts of 1946, is hereby further amended by striking
4 out the second sentence thereof and inserting in its
5 place the following: — The commissioner shall receive
6 such salary not exceeding twelve thousand dollars,
7 as the governor and council determine.

1 SECTION 2. Section 6 of chapter 26 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 591 of
3 the acts of 1946, is hereby further amended by striking
4 out the second sentence thereof and inserting in its
5 place the following: — The commissioner shall receive
6 such salary not exceeding twelve thousand dollars as
7 the governor and council determine.
