AN ACT TO RELIEVE SMALL HOME OWNERS FROM THE CRUSHING BURDEN OF REAL ESTATE TAXATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 59, section 5 of the General Laws, as
2 amended, is hereby further amended by inserting after
3 paragraph thirty-fifth thereof the following new
4 paragraph: —

5 Thirty-sixth. The first three thousand dollars of
6 assessed valuation of any real property intended
7 primarily for a dwelling or for dwelling purposes and
8 while in use as a dwelling. This amount shall be in
9 addition to any exemptions provided in paragraphs
10 twenty-second and twenty-third, as amended, of this
11 section.
