By Mr. Durkin of Salem (by request), petition of Joseph B. Harrington that the city of Salem be authorized to sell certain land held by it for park purposes. Cities.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SALEM TO SELL CERTAIN
LAND HELD BY IT FOR PARK PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Salem, by its mayor, when
2 so authorized by the city council, may sell and convey
3 free and clear from any obligation to use the same for
4 park purposes or any other public purposes, a certain
5 parcel of land situated in the Forest river area, so
6 called, and more particularly bounded and described
7 as follows:— westerly by land of Kimball, Lavoie,
8 Poitras, Lamprey and Raymond about two hundred
9 and eighty feet; northerly by land of Odell and
10 Clifton avenue about twenty-seven feet; easterly by
11 Forest River park on various courses about three
12 hundred and twenty feet.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect when, after
2 recommendation by the board of park commissioners
3 of the city of Salem, it is accepted by the city council
4 of said city, subject to the provisions of its charter,
5 during the current year.
