AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SALEM TO USE CERTAIN LAND FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL ATHLETIC ACTIVITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Salem is hereby authorized
2 to use the stadium and athletic field known as Bertram
3 field, so called, now under the control of its board of
4 park commissioners and not required for park pur-
5 poses, for public school athletic purposes. The land
6 and stadium so used shall be under the same care and
7 control as other school property.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
