## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT TO PLACE THE POSITION OF CLERK OF WORKS,  
TRANSIT DEPARTMENT, CITY OF BOSTON, UNDER THE  
CIVIL SERVICE LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The position of clerk of works, transit  
2 department, city of Boston, shall upon the effective  
3 date of this act, become subject to the civil service  
4 laws and the rules and regulations made thereunder.

5 The incumbent of said office on said effective date,  
6 shall be subjected to a non-competitive qualifying  
7 examination for said position by the division of civil  
8 service of the department of civil service and regis-  
9 tration.

10 If said incumbent passes said examination, he shall  
11 be certified for said position and shall be deemed to  
12 be permanently appointed.

1 SECTION 2. Upon passage of this act and compli-  
2 ance of the present incumbent with all the provisions  
3 of this act, said incumbent shall be permitted to par-  
4 ticipate in the Boston retirement system and shall be  
5 permitted to pay all arrears from date of employment.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
