AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF CERTAIN IN-SIGNIA TO BE WORN BY HUNTERS, TRAPPERS AND FISH-ERMEN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 131 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by inserting after section 118 the following section: —  
3 *Section 118A.* There shall be furnished with each  
4 hunting, fishing or trapping license issued by the  
5 department of conservation a license insignia bearing  
6 the license number, and no person shall hunt for,  
7 kill, pursue or take in any manner any of the animals,  
8 fish or birds, permitted to be taken under such license,  
9 unless the insignia be at such time continually dis-  
10 played on the outer garment of such person in such a  
11 manner that the license figures are plainly visible  
12 and legible. The insignia shall be made of water-  
13 proof material and shall be not less than nine inches  
14 in length and three inches in width and shall have  
15 numbers not less than two and one half inches in  
16 size.
