AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW STATE HIGHWAY IN THE TOWN OF SUTTON, EXTENDING FROM THE DOUGLAS LINE TO THE MILLBURY TOWN LINE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The state department of public works is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to lay out and construct a  
3 new highway from the Douglas town line through the  
4 town of Sutton to the Millbury town line. For the  
5 purpose of this act said department may expend such  
6 sums, not exceeding                      dollars as may here-  
7 after be appropriated from the Highway Fund.
