AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN REQUIRED PRINTED EXPENSES IN APPEALS UNDER THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 11 of chapter 152, General Laws, is hereby
- 2 amended by adding the following paragraph:—
- 3 If the employee, or his dependents, appeal from a
- 4 decree of the superior court, upon motion before the
- 5 superior court, a justice may certify that the appeal
- 6 is on a matter of law, reasonably raised, and, if such
- 7 certification is made, the necessary record shall be
- 8 printed at the expense of the commonwealth.
