AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE INCREASE IN SALARIES OF THE
REGISTERS OF DEEDS, ASSISTANT REGISTERS OF DEEDS
AND THE EMPLOYEES OF THE REGISTRIES OF DEEDS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 The salaries of the registers of deeds, assistant
2 registers of deeds and the employees of the registries
3 of deeds of the various counties shall, with the excep-
4 tion of Suffolk county, be increased in an amount
5 equal to fifteen per cent of the salaries in effect on
6 December thirty-first nineteen hundred and forty-
7 eight and shall be paid by the respective counties;
8 and the salaries of the registers of deeds shall be in
9 full for all services rendered as register and as assist-
10 ant recorder of the land court.
