AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE MINIMUM COMPENSATION OF
PROBATION OFFICERS IN COUNTIES OTHER THAN SUFFOLK
FOR FULL-TIME SERVICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 83 of chapter 276 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section 1 of chapter 566
3 of the acts of the current year and chapter 639 of the
4 acts of 1947 is hereby further amended by inserting
5 immediately before the last sentence the following
6 sentence:—The minimum compensation of any pro-
7 bation officer in any county, other than Suffolk, whose
8 service is determined by the county commissioners
9 thereof to be full-time service shall be three thousand
10 dollars per annum.
