AN ACT PLACING THE INCUMBENTS OF THE OFFICE OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TRANSIT DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON UNDER PERMANENT APPOINTMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of
2 General Laws to the contrary, the incumbents of the
3 office of commissioners of the transit department of
4 the city of Boston shall have an unlimited tenure of
5 office.

1 SECTION 2. The persons holding the office of com-
2 missioners of the transit department of the city of
3 Boston on January second, nineteen hundred and
4 forty-nine, shall be deemed to be permanently ap-
5 pointed thereto and shall not be removed there-
6 from nor shall the office be abolished except for just
7 cause and in accordance with the provisions of sec-
8 tions forty-three and forty-five of chapter thirty-one
9 of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
