AN ACT PROVIDING CERTAIN CREDITS IN PROMOTIONAL EXAMINATIONS FOR POLICE OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 A police officer who has taken an examination for
2 appointment to the rank or grade next highest to
3 that held by him at the time of said examination,
4 shall be entitled to have his mark increased by the
5 division of civil service by two points if he is the
6 holder of a medal of honor, one point if he is the
7 holder of a commendation for meritorious service and
8 one point if he has been commended in general orders.
