AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TEACHING OF THE PRINCIPLES  
OF CONSUMER CO-OPERATION AND OF WORK AND IN-  
DUSTRIAL UNIONS IN CERTAIN PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

- 1 The principles of consumer co-operation and of
- 2 trade and industrial unions shall be taught in every
- 3 high school in the commonwealth.
