### AN ACT TO FACILITATE VOTING AT STATE AND NATIONAL ELECTIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any law to the  
2 contrary, the secretary of state shall make provision  
3 on the ballot and voting machines to be used at each  
4 state and national election so that a voter may vote  
5 for each candidate for office under the same political  
6 party designation by making a single cross on the  
7 ballot or by operating a single lever on the voting  
8 machine, as the case may be.
