

HOUSE No. 1537

By Mr. Tompkins of Concord, petition of Raymond P. Baldwin relative to a right of way for public access for certain purposes to White Pond in the towns of Concord and Sudbury. Harbors and Public Lands.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO A RIGHT OF WAY FOR PUBLIC ACCESS FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES TO WHITE POND IN THE TOWNS OF CONCORD AND SUDBURY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 294 of the acts of
2 1947 is hereby amended by adding, after the words
3 "public access" in line 3 thereof, the following
4 clause: — , as provided in section four of this act.

1 SECTION 2. Section 4 of chapter 294 of the acts of
2 1947 is hereby amended by striking out said section
3 and by substituting therefor the following new
4 section: —

5 *Section 4.* Said right of way shall be limited to
6 public access by inhabitants of the commonwealth
7 for the purpose of hunting, boating and fishing sub-
8 ject to rules and regulations as provided in section
9 thirty-four of chapter one hundred and thirty-one of

10 the General Laws, and to access by public officials in
11 the performance of their duties including access by
12 tank trucks and other public vehicles for the purpose
13 of stocking said pond with fish; and said right of way
14 shall not be discontinued or abandoned without au-
15 thority therefor from the general court.
