### AN ACT RELATIVE TO BENEFITS UNDER THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW, SO CALLED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 151A of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by inserting after section 22 the following  
3 section:—

4 *Section 22A.* Any person who is eligible to receive  
5 benefits under this chapter and who is sixty-five years  
6 of age or older shall not be required to appear at an  
7 office of the division of employment security or to  
8 sign any application for benefits or statement rela-  
9 tive thereto in any calendar year except in connection  
10 with and as a part of his initial application for such  
11 benefits.
