### AN ACT RELATIVE TO AGREEMENTS FOR THE ARBITRATION AND CONCILIATION OF LABOR DISPUTES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the con-  
2 trary, all arbitration and conciliation provisions of  
3 collective bargaining agreements for arbitration and  
4 conciliation before public or private arbitration and  
5 conciliation tribunals shall be valid, and where, by  
6 agreement of the parties to collective bargaining agree-  
7 ments the determination of the tribunal of any issue  
8 shall be final, such determination shall be deemed  
9 final and be enforceable by proper judicial proceedings.
