AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TIME FOR SUBMITTING TO
VOTERS THE QUESTION OF LICENSING THE SALE OF
ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by section 1 of chapter 207 of the acts of
3 1936, is hereby further amended by striking out the
4 first three lines of section 11 and substituting therefor
5 the following:— The state secretary shall cause to
6 be placed on the official ballot used in cities and
7 towns at the state election held in the year nine-
8 teen hundred and forty-eight and at state elections
9 held every four years thereafter,— and by strik-
10 ing out, in line 4 of the paragraph next following
11 paragraph (e) of said section eleven, the word “two”
12 and substituting therefor the word:— four.
