AN ACT EXEMPTING PARAPLEGIC WAR VETERANS FROM ALL PROPERTY TAXES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law, no
2 tax of any kind shall hereafter be assessed by the
3 commonwealth, or by any political subdivision thereof,
4 upon the property, real or personal, of any paraplegic
5 war veteran, and any such tax which has been so
6 assessed shall not be collected from such veteran.
