### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SUPERVISION OF COMMERCIAL DRIVERS OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The registrar of motor vehicles is hereby author-  
2 ized and directed to establish an office force to  
3 handle all commercial drivers with special rules re-  
4 garding revocation or suspension of the license of  
5 any person who drives a motor coach, taxi or truck  
6 as an occupation.
