AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A TEN PER CENT PREFERENCE ON  
CIVIL SERVICE EXAMINATIONS FOR MEMBERS OF THE  
AMERICAN GOLD STAR MOTHERS, INC.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 Any member of The American Gold Star Mothers,  
2 Inc., who takes a civil service examination for ap-  
3 pointment to the public service, shall have the mark  
4 actively received by her on such examination raised  
5 by ten per cent thereof for the purpose of establishing  
6 her rank among those who took such examination.

THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES

ARTICLE I

SECTION 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

SECTION 2

Representatives and Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in that State.
