AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF SWEEP SEINES IN THE WATERS OF PROVINCETOWN HARBOR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The use of sweep seines in the waters
2 of Provincetown harbor is hereby prohibited. Who-
3 ever violates any provision of this act shall be punished
4 by a fine of not less than five hundred nor more than
5 one thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
