### AN ACT INCREASING THE FEE TO BE PAID TO WITNESSES IN CRIMINAL CASES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 29 of chapter 262 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby  
3 amended by adding at the end of the first sentence  
4 the following:— ; provided, further, that the fees  
5 for attending as a witness before a court sitting for  
6 criminal business shall be three dollars a day.
