AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PLAYGROUND ON RIVER STREET AT THE JUNCTION OF REDDY AVENUE IN HYDE PARK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby
2 authorized and directed to set up and establish a
3 small public playground for young children on land
4 now owned by it on River street at the junction of
5 Reddy avenue in the Hyde Park district of Boston,
6 between the Tileston and Hollingsworth building and
7 the Doyle Post, Veterans of Foreign Wars building.
8 For such purpose the said commission is hereby
9 authorized to expend such amount as may hereafter
10 be appropriated therefor.
