AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE AREA

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

5 slope and a toboggan slide, and otherwise to develop
