### AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE ROADWAY OF THE HARVARD BRIDGE, SO CALLED.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby
- 2 authorized and directed to reconstruct the roadway
- 3 of the Harvard bridge, so called, over the Charles
- 4 river between the cities of Boston and Cambridge.
- 5 For said purpose, said commission may expend such
- 6 sums as may be appropriated therefor.
