AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE BY THE COMMONWEALTH TO CERTAIN PERSONS, WHO SERVED IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES DURING WORLD WAR II, OF THE MASSACHUSETTS DISTINGUISHED SERVICE CROSS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 In recognition of and as a mark of appreciation for
2 services rendered in the armed forces of the United
3 States during World War II, the adjutant general,
4 subject to appropriation and in co-operation with the
5 state treasurer, shall cause to be issued and delivered
6 to each person entitled to the benefits of section one
7 of chapter seven hundred and thirty-one of the acts
8 of nineteen hundred and forty-five, who received an
9 honorary citation for his wartime service, a suitable
10 medal, to be known as the Massachusetts Distinguished
11 Service Cross.
