AN ACT INCREASING THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES OF CERTAIN WAR VETERANS IN THE PUBLIC SERVICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The first paragraph of section 56 of
2 chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in

4 "one half" and inserting in place thereof the words:—
5 two thirds.
