By Mr. Toomey of Cambridge, petition of the Massachusetts Police & Fire Association for legislation to establish a minimum annual pension for retired policemen and firemen. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Forty-Nine.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MINIMUM ANNUAL PENSION FOR RETIRED POLICEMEN AND FIREMEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provi-
2 sion of law, the minimum annual pension payable to
3 any retired policeman or fireman shall be eighteen
4 hundred dollars.

1 SECTION 2. Nothing in this act shall be taken to
2 require a decrease in the amount of any pension now
3 being paid to any policeman or fireman.
