AN ACT RELATIVE TO PAYMENT IN CERTAIN CASES FOR
MEDICAL, HOSPITAL AND OTHER SERVICES RENDERED ON
ACCOUNT OF RECIPIENTS OF OLD AGE ASSISTANCE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 118A of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by section 2 of chapter 683
3 of the acts of 1945, is hereby further amended by
4 inserting after the third sentence the following sen-
5 tence:— In addition, expenses for medical, hospital
6 and other services rendered on account of any re-
7 cipient of old age assistance, including expenses of
8 the funeral of any such recipient who may have died,
9 may be paid by the town directly to the person
10 furnishing such services, subject to any rule or regu-
11 lation of the department relative to reimbursement
12 under this chapter, in any case where such payment
13 is necessary to discharge an obligation incurred in
14 securing such services for such recipient.
