### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF POLICE OFFICERS IN CERTAIN TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 in section 85E, subsection (c), by striking out the  
3 word "sixty" and inserting the word: — fifty-five, —  
4 so as to read as follows: — (c) Any permanent member  
5 of said department, at his request, at any time after  
6 attaining the age of fifty-five and before attaining the  
7 age of sixty if he has performed faithful service  
8 therein for not less than twenty years continuously.
