By Mr. Folsom of Lynn, petition of Edward R. Butterworth for further regulation of retirement allowances payable to certain officers in the Division of State Police. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT TO FURTHER REGULATE THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS IN THE DIVISION OF STATE POLICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 26 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out subdivision 3 (c), in-
3 serted by section 1 of chapter 658 of the acts of 1945,
4 and inserting in place thereof the following: —

5 (c) Upon retirement under the provisions of this
6 subdivision a member shall receive a retirement allow-
7 ance to become effective on the date of his retirement.
8 Payments under such allowance shall be made as
9 provided for in sections twelve and thirteen and the
10 normal yearly amount thereof shall be equal to two
11 thirds of the annual rate of his regular compensation
12 immediately preceding the date his retirement allow-
13 ance becomes effective.
