AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT OF POLICE OFFICERS IN CERTAIN CITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 in section 83A, (c), by striking out the word "sixty"
3 and inserting the word: — fifty-five, — so as to read
4 as follows: — Any permanent member of said depart-
5 ment, at his request, at any time after attaining the
6 age of fifty-five and before attaining the age of sixty
7 if he has performed faithful service therein for not
8 less than twenty years continuously.
