AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF EDWARD J. SHAUGHNESSY OF MEDFORD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Edward J. Shaughnessy of Medford, who was
2 retired on August twenty-fourth, nineteen hundred
3 and forty-five, because of accidental disability, shall
4 be entitled to the benefit of all pertinent provisions
5 of paragraph (2) of section seven of chapter thirty-
6 two of the General Laws, as amended by chapter
7 four hundred and forty-six of the acts of nineteen
8 hundred and forty-eight, to the same extent as if he
9 was retired subsequent to June first, nineteen hundred
10 and forty-eight, and at the same rate of salary which
11 said position was classified on the latter date.
