By Mr. Murphy of Malden, petition of Robert F. Murphy (approved by the mayor and city council) that the city of Malden be authorized to pension Arthur D. Madden, a former school janitor in said city. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RETIREMENT ALLOWANCE OF
ARTHUR D. MADDEN, A FORMER SCHOOL JANITOR IN THE
CITY OF MALDEN.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Malden is hereby authorized
2 to pay Arthur D. Madden, a former school janitor,
3 a pension in the sum of ten hundred twenty-three
4 dollars and twenty-five cents per annum, the said
5 sum being equivalent to one half the highest annual
6 salary received by said Arthur D. Madden. Said
7 payment shall be retroactive to June twenty-sixth,
8 nineteen hundred and forty-six, and there shall be
9 deducted from said payments the sums heretofore
10 paid to said Arthur D. Madden by said city on ac-
11 count of said pension.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
